Artist teams may submit **1 work only** in jpg format up to 1700pixels, 200ppi

File must be labeled with both last names and title of work. Ex: **LastName_LastName_titleofwork.jpg**

A brief statement describing your shared experience must be included as a word document

The word document with statement must include each team member's name, age, city/town, title of work, medium, and emails. This doc must also state your agreement that AARP and IAC may use this material however we see fit to promote the exhibit.

Interviews with selected teams will be arranged and conducted by Waldo Cabrera

Headshots of each artist in jpg format up to 1700pixels, 200ppi
